



2025 Fraserview PAR 3»4 Leagues FAQ's



Who hosts the Fraserview PAR 3»4 Leagues & how long have the Leagues been running?

With the generous support of the [Vancouver Park Board](#), the [Fraserview Golf Academy](#) (“FGA”) hosts the Fraserview PAR 3»4 Leagues as an integrated set of FGA [Get Golf Ready](#) transition-to-the-course programs. The PAR 3 Summer League was launched in 2022; the PAR 3 Spring League and PAR 4 Fall League were added in 2023; and a pre-season group lesson on golf skills fundamentals was added to the PAR 3 program in 2024.

When and where will the 2025 PAR 3 Spring & Summer Leagues play, & what’s included in PAR 3 League registration?

The 2025 PAR 3 Spring League (April 15 – May 25) & Summer League (July 8 – August 23) each include:

- A preliminary 2-hour group lesson with a FGA teaching professional at [Fraserview Golf Course](#)
 - Full swing & shot making fundamentals
 - Short game & putting fundamentals
 - Registered PAR 3 players may choose between 4-6 pm & 6-8 pm time slots, offered on two separate dates about a week before the Spring & Summer League seasons get underway
- Pre-arranged tee times for 4 League games per week for 6 weeks, alternating weekly between Vancouver’s [Queen Elizabeth Park \(QE\)](#) and [Rupert Park \(RP\)](#) Par 3 courses (max. enrolment of 12 players per game & 36 players per League roster)
 - One weekly game is guaranteed for each registered PAR 3 League player
 - All registered players welcome to join up to three games during each week of scheduled League play (if space allows, on a first-come, first-served basis)
 - Players are responsible for their own green fees, clubs & balls.
- A 30-minute training workshop at the designated course’s practice area before each scheduled League game
 - Led by a PGA teaching professional or FGA-trained facilitator, and covering one of the PAR 3 program’s four educational elements:
 - ⇒ 1) Pace of Play;
 - ⇒ 2) Safety on the Golf Course;
 - ⇒ 3) Golf Etiquette (i.e. Respect – for other golfers, the golf course, staff, and the integrity of the game); &
 - ⇒ 4) Basic Rules of Golf
- Guidance through the PAR 3 learning process by trained FGA facilitators, who will supervise the pre-game training workshops and a portion of each on-course game

Can anyone join the Fraserview PAR 3»4 Leagues?

PAR 3 League players are expected to have some basic golf training &/or playing experience. The PAR 3 Spring & Summer League programs are intended for new golfers who have taken some lessons and now want to make the transition from the driving range and practice green to **playing the game, on the golf course.**

Spring or Summer League participants who demonstrate adequate understanding and application of the PAR 3 program’s four educational elements will be eligible for the 2025 PAR 4 Fall League.

When and where will the 2025 PAR 4 Fall League play, & what will be included in Fall League registration?

The 2025 PAR 4 Fall League will provide full-size course (executive distance tees) experience and guidance, with four classes arranged weekly at [Fraserview Golf Course](#) through the month of October (dates and tee times subject to course availability, weather conditions and player enrolment). Each PAR 4 League class will include: pre-game warm-up activities; guidance with course strategy & game management; supervised on-course play; and complimentary use of loaner clubs, warm-up balls, and Fraserview's driving range + short game teaching areas during scheduled PAR 4 League classes.

Players who attend **all four** PAR 4 League sessions will receive a **2025 Fraserview PAR 3»4 Leagues Performance Report/Passport**: outlining our **PAR 3»4** performance standards for knowledge and application of the PAR 3 learning elements in a full-size course setting (1. Prompt Pace of Play; 2. Safety on the Course; 3. Golf Etiquette (Respect – for other golfers, the golf course, staff, and the integrity of the game); & 4. Basic Rules of Golf); and noting **COMPETENCY ACHIEVED** for each standard met.

How will players sign up for their weekly PAR 3 Spring & Summer League games?

Players may pre-book **ONE** Spring/Summer League class each week of scheduled play, using [Fraserview Golf Academy's online booking system](#) (scroll to the bottom of the page & click on BOOK TIME AT QUEEN ELIZABETH for Weeks 1, 3 & 5, or BOOK TIME AT RUPERT PARK for Weeks 2, 4 & 6). Each week's Spring / Summer League classes will be available for online booking from the previous Friday morning (by 9:00 AM) until 9:00 AM Monday. Spring and Summer League participants will be welcome to enroll in multiple classes (up to 3 in total) each week via WhatsApp, space permitting.

Instructions for joining and using our PAR 3»4 Leagues WhatsApp chats will be emailed to registered players during the week before each League's season gets underway.

How much will it cost to register and play in the 2025 Fraserview PAR 3»4 Leagues?

Each Spring and Summer League participant will be charged a one-time registration fee of \$99 plus GST. Players will be responsible for their own green fees, clubs and balls. See the [Queen Elizabeth Park Pitch & Putt](#) and [Rupert Park Pitch & Putt](#) websites for their 2025 green fee and equipment rental rates.

Each Fall League participant will be charged a one-time registration fee of \$119 plus GST (includes use of Fraserview range and short game area, & on-course play without green fee during scheduled PAR 4 League classes). Loaner clubs will be available and range balls will be provided without charge to registered Fall League players.

How can I register?

Players may register to play in the 2025 Fraserview PAR 3 Spring &/or Summer League through the [fraserviewgolfacademy.com](#) website (starting March 15 for Spring League & May 15 for Summer League). PAR 4 Fall League registration will open following completion of the Summer League season. Eligible PAR 3 Spring/Summer League graduates will receive their invitation & directions to register for the 2025 PAR 4 Fall League by email (max. 24 participants).
